

MOVE-IN/OUT INFORMATION GRANVILLE ISLAND

MOVE-IN DATES & TIMES

In-Water boat exhibitors will be scheduled to move in at Granville Island during the following times and hours:

Monday, January 30, 2023 8am – 6pm (boat exhibitors)
Tuesday, January 31, 2023 8am – 6pm (boat exhibitors)

Exhibitors should be aware that they will receive a Move-In EMAIL with an excel spreadsheet that details the designated time to move their boats into their slips.

Please note that due to limited transient moorage available, there is no ability to accommodate early move-in requests.

Several areas of the show will be tight for space and in order to facilitate a smooth process for everyone – exhibitors will be required to adhere to their window of time.

There will be Vancouver Boat Show Staff on-site to assist you – please look for them in Red Jackets as you arrive.

SHIPPING ADDRESS

Shipments can be sent to the Granville Island Maritime Market and Marina and be directed to your display for delivery. There will not be any forklift service available at this site so please ensure anything you ship is able to be unloaded and delivered to your display by the courier company.

Deliveries cannot be accepted at Granville Island prior to Monday, January 30, 2023. C.O.D. shipments **will not** be accepted. All freight must be prepaid.

ELECTRICAL

In-water boat exhibitors who require 30-amp or 50-amp power for their boats must pre-request power on the Boats To Be Exhibited In-Water Form, and you must bring your own cords/pig tails.

LIVE ABOARD PASSES

Exhibitors and crews staying aboard boats during the show are required to obtain a Live Aboard Pass from the Show Office Tent at the entrance to the marina. This pass, along with an Exhibitor Badge will allow access after show hours and both must be shown to Show Security.

SHOW SECURITY

Access to the in-water location will be permitted for Exhibitors 2 hours before show opening each day, and 30 minutes after show closing each day

NEW – The In-Water Venue closes at 5:30pm, Wednesday through Saturday, and 5pm on Sunday.

Exhibitors will be required to show their Exhibitor Badge to Security at the entrance. After show hours, security will patrol the in-water location, restricting public access to the docks. Marina members will have access to their boats moored in Granville Island.

During Show Hours the public will be required to purchase a ticket to the Vancouver Boat Show (purchased at either BC Place or the Granville Island entrances) or show a hand-stamp received at BC Place, or provide an Exhibitor Guest Ticket.
